Science Vocabulary:

Photosynthesis Vocabulary

- 1. <u>Photosynthesis</u> the process where plants use sunlight, water, and carbon dioxide to produce sugar and release oxygen
- 2. Oxygen a waste product produced by plants during photosynthesis that animals use for respiration
- 3. <u>Carbon Dioxide</u> a gas produced by cells during respiration; used in photosynthesis to produce sugars
- 4. <u>Glucose</u> the compound produced through photosynthesis which plants use as food
- 5. Convert change from one form to another
- 6. Fuel a substance that produces power or energy
- 7. Organism any living thing
- 8. Radiant energy energy from the sun that reaches Earth as visible light, ultraviolet and infrared (heat) radiation
- 9. <u>Element</u> a material that cannot be broken down into anything simpler [example: O (oxygen)]
- Compound when two or more elements combine [example: CO2 (carbon dioxide)]
