1. **Drama**- a story that is performed on a stage
2. **Motivations**- the reasons why characters act, think, and feel as they do
3. **Character**- person, animal or made-up creature in a story or play
4. **Character traits**- special qualities of characters, such as shyness or honesty, that makes one character different from another
5. **Adventurous**- not afraid to do new and dangerous or exciting things
6. **Suspicious**- causing a feeling that something is wrong or that someone is behaving wrongly
7. **Confident**- having a feeling or belief that you can do something well
8. **Independent**- not relying on other people for help
9. **Loyal**- having or showing complete support for someone or something
10. **Compassionate**- feeling or showing concern for someone who is sick, hurt, poor
