Summer Reading Project

DUE: 2 Weeks After School Begins

Directions: Create a photo/picture presentation using at least 8 photos/pictures to demonstrate your understanding of at least 8 life lessons taught by Morrie in the book *Tuesdays with Morrie*. Follow the steps below.

Step 1: Choose at least 8 life lessons that made an impression on you while reading the book. Record **page numbers** and **quotes** from each lesson that you choose from the book.

Step 2: In your own words, explain what you think Morrie was meaning through the lesson he shared. Break it down in detail and tell me your interpretation of the lesson. This is basically a paraphrase of the lesson in your own words.

Step 3: Decide on possible subjects to take photographs of, or find pictures that will illustrate the lessons you have chosen. You may select pictures from magazines, the Internet, and newspapers. If you choose to take your own photos, a disposable camera is satisfactory (you will also need to have the film developed). Black and white photos/pictures could add an artistic flare to the project.

Step 4: Create a written explanation/analysis for each photo/picture that **clearly** explains how the photo/picture illustrates the lesson you have just discussed.

Step 5: Create a neat, organized, and creative method for displaying your project. You may wish to choose one of the following options, combine options, or create something completely original! Some ideas may include:

- Poster
- Scrapbook
- PowerPoint/Prezi
- iMovie
- Portfolio
