# Policy:

## TITLE I PARENT AND FAMILY ENGAGEMENT REGULATIONS

In order to achieve the level of Title I parent involvement desired by the board of education policy on this topic, these regulations guide the development of each school's annual plan designed to foster a cooperative effort among the parents, school, and community.

### GUIDELINES

Parent involvement activities developed at each school will include opportunities for:

- 1. Volunteering;
- 2. Parent education;
- 3. Home support for child's education;
- 4. Parent participation in school decision-making.

The school system will provide opportunities for professional development and resources for staff and parent/community regarding effective parent involvement practices.

### ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Parents

It is the responsibility of the parent to:

- 1. actively communicate with school staff;
- 2. be aware of rules and regulations of the school;
- 3. take an active role in the child's education by reinforcing, at home, the skills and knowledge the student has learned in school; and
- 4. utilize opportunities for participation in school activities.
- 2. Staff

It is the responsibility of the staff to:

- 1. develop and implement a school plan for parent involvement;
- 2. promote and encourage parent involvement activities;
- 3. effectively and actively communicate with all parents about skills, knowledge, and attributes student are learning in school and suggestions for reinforcement; and
- 4. send information to parents of Title I children in a format and to the extent practicable, in a language the parents can understand.

### 3. Community

Community members who volunteer in the schools have the responsibility to:

1. be aware of rules and regulations of the school; and

2. utilize opportunities for participation in school activities.

#### 4. Administration

It is the responsibility of the administration to:

- 1. facilitate and implement the Title I Parent Involvement policy and plan;
- 2. provide training and space for parent involvement activities;
- 3. provide resources to support successful parent involvement practices;
- 4. provide in-service education to staff regarding the value and use of contribution of parents on how to communicate with and work with parents as equals partners; and
- 5. send information to parents of Title I children in a format and, to the extent practicable, in a language the parents can understand.
