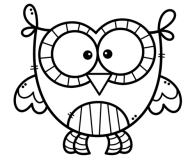

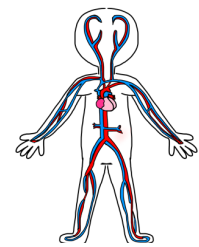

*Tale of Despereaux Vocabulary*

1. **honor:** respect that is given to someone who is admired
2. **ominous:** something bad or unpleasant is going to happen
3. **monument:** a building, statue, etc., that honors a person or event
4. **disappointment:** the feeling of sadness or displeasure
5. **knight:** a soldier in the past who had a high social rank and who fought while riding a horse and usually wearing armor
6. **despair:** complete loss of hope
7. **contemplate:** look thoughtfully for a long time
8. **abyss:** a deep bottomless hole or pit
9. **content:** pleased and satisfied; not needing more
10. **clever:** showing intelligent thinking
