Three ways to access the MackinVia Digital Library:

- Login to your Clever account and click on MackinVia.
- Go to www.mackinvia.com.
- Download the MackinVia app from the App Store or Google Play Store.



How to login:

- Type your school name, it will appear in the dropdown box.
- User ID is student MSIS number, without any leading zeroes, followed by @students.pearlk12.com.
Example: 1234567@students.pearlk12.com
- Student password is DOB, formatted as M/D/YYYY.

All-State Music Camp

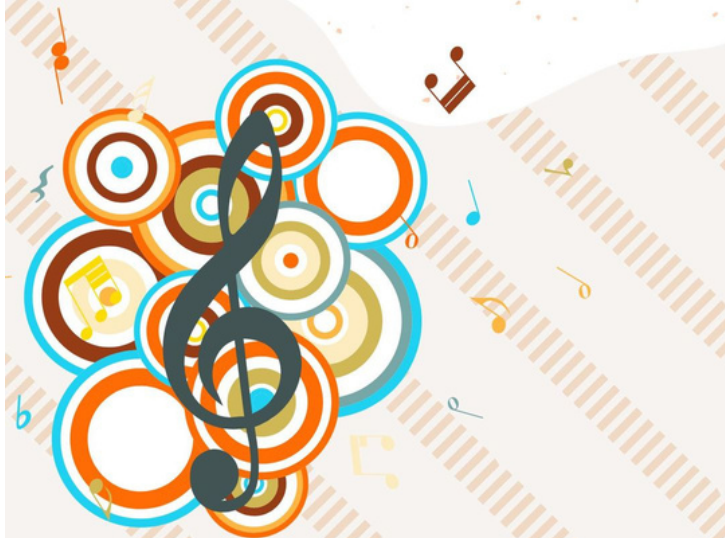
